May the God of endurance and encouragement give you the same attitude toward each other, similar to Christ Jesus's attitude. That way you can glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ together with one voice.

-Romans 15:5-6

Paul extends this blessing near the end of his letter to Christians in Rome. It follows his discourse regarding how to welcome and care for one another as Christ cares for us. A few chapters back he commands, "Love each other like the members of your family. Be the best at showing honor to each other."

Paul reminds them that no one person or group is better than another. Those who have more should help those who have less. Those who are seasoned in the faith should come alongside those who are new. Those at odds should work toward reconciliation. There should never be a sense that some are worth more than others because in Christ we become something new together.

Being the church means God's love forms the center of our lives, governing our thoughts, words, and actions. This love isn't warm fuzzies, but a *deliberate lived action*. This is something we have to work at, because like anything, Jesus's call requires nurture and exercise. And that gives glory to God.

As most of you know my wife, Brittany, is a Physical Therapist. She often sees patients who, due to various ailments, experience weakness and even atrophy in certain joints and muscles because of disuse or injury.

Atrophy is not just a matter of losing strength. To recover from it the body has to relearn that particular muscle's mechanics all over again. Once that foundation is re-laid strengthening can begin. After that therapy, maintenance begins through regular exercise. "If you don't use it you lose it," they say.

The same goes for following Jesus. If we do not regularly exercise and strengthen those aspects of our lives, they will weaken and even atrophy, which can leave us feeling disconnected and even indifferent. The exercise of discipleship requires small conscious decisions. And like healing, it doesn't happen overnight. It happens as we build up endurance over a lifetime and participate in the church.

How might God be calling us to exercise our faith? Are we loving one another and our neighbors in ways that point them to Jesus and to the church? If so, good, keep going! If not, grace abounds, and the best time to start is now.
